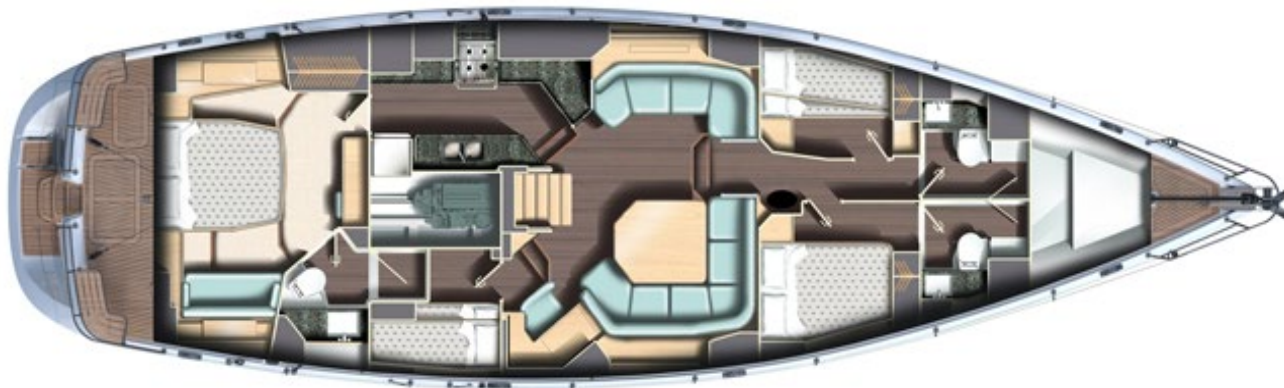

Peregrine Falcon is a stunning example of the Oyster 625. Her interior has a light contemporary feel with maples and walnut flooring, which enhances the feeling of space below, the port and starboard vertical seascape windows, let in the light and ensures you always catch the view.

On deck, Peregrine Falcon has a spacious cockpit area with a large bimini covering the central cockpit and helm. There is a large cockpit table to allow outside dining.

Peregrine Falcon is fitted with a new carbon mast with V-boom and a furling code 0 to guarantee the best sailing experience even in the light wind.
