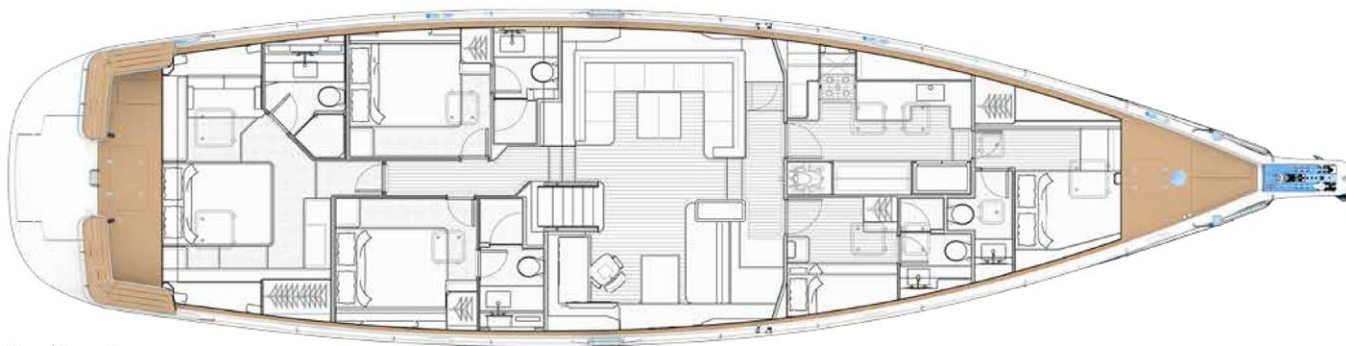

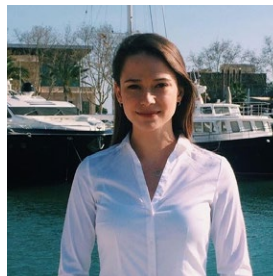
Captain - Thomas Auckland
